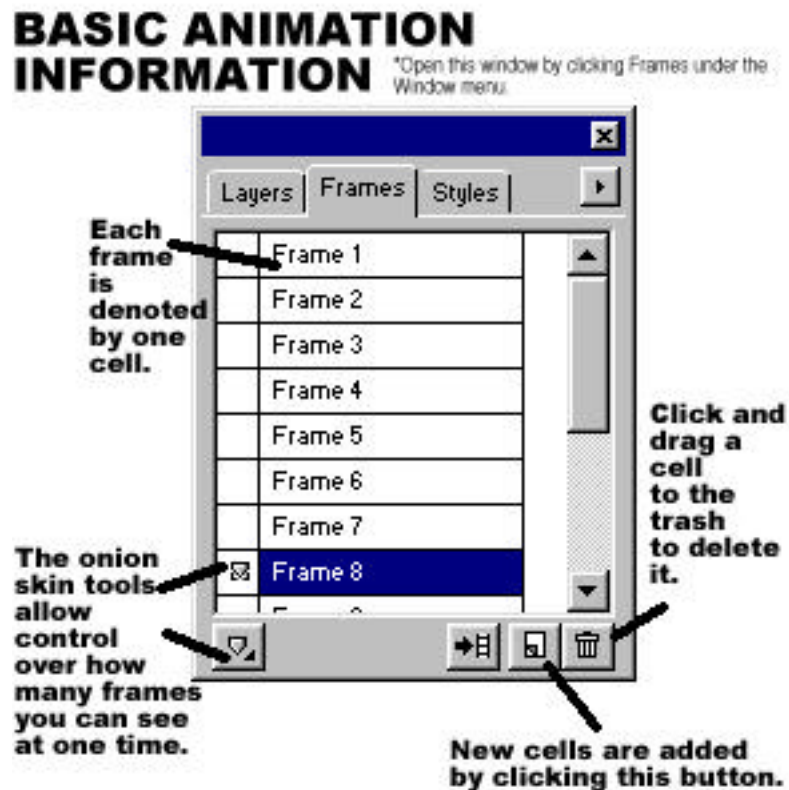

# Graphics Animation I Handout

Graphics animation with Fireworks means creating animated .GIF files. In this case, animation means the stringing together of frames where, like in a motion picture, each frame is a snapshot of one part of the action. When viewed one after the other, the frames create the illusion of movement.

In Fireworks, the tool for creating frames can be found in the Windows menu. Clicking on the word 'Frames' will open the following window:



The rest of animation is done frame by frame by creating elements, copying, pasting, and manipulating those elements, and then Exporting the finished frames to an animated .GIF file.
